Which in turn led them to discover Amina's Invisible Plaster In-Wall Loudspeakers. These unique loudspeakers give a new solution to the traditional design question: How do you install loudspeakers without cluttering-up your sleek interior?

An uncluttered fresh feel was needed

Amina's Invisible Plaster In-Wall Loudspeakers do exactly as it says: Mount within a plasterboard opening or in a ceiling, skim over with 1-2 plaster skim, let the plaster dry, decorate and the speakers become invisible. Rich room filling sounds

They create audio in a different way and one that is much better at dispersing sound throughout large rooms compared with traditional loudspeakers. The audio Amina loudspeakers radiate in a hemispherical wave which sweeps through the space to give a more even, ambient coverage

The 'hot and cold' spots are much reduced and the detail of higher frequencies is retained.

At the Maes-Yr-Haf 4 x AIW3 40W speakers were used fitted in to the walls to provide audio throughout the main dining area.

The Amina solution meant there were no speakers jutting into room to make it feel cluttered or to create discord (whether consciously or subliminally) with the design. Which left the room feeling much more airy and relaxed.
